Monday, October 11th through Thursday, October 14th was spirit week for South Middle School. Monday was pajama day, Tuesday was Hawaiin day, Wednesday was twin day and Thursday was Green and Gold Day. 6TH GRADE MATH

Sixth graders are currently working on solving multi-digit computations with the order of operations. New for 6th grade is evaluating exponents with fractional bases. We have already extended knowledge of decimal operations with long division and multiplication as well as activities that help students explore mean, median and mode for a given set of data. We most recently completed our geometry unit where we focused on the relationship between the volume and surface area of a cube, identifying polygons and polyhedra, and finding the surface area of any polyhedron's net. To finish the semester we will begin analyzing ratios and rates, including percentages. By the end of the semester ask your student to apply what they have learned and calculate the percentage they earn on any of their assignments. This is a meaningful way for students to connect what they have learned to their real world experiences.

HALLOWEEN DANCE

Student Council is sponsoring a Halloween Dance featuring DJ Cain on Friday, October 29th from 7-9 pm at South Middle. Halloween costumes are encouraged under these guidelines: no face paint, staff must be able to see the students face (no body suits) and the costume must be school appropriate. Additional Information to Know:

* Students will enter through Door #17 on the south end of the building.

- * School personnel will be the final judge of the appropriateness of a particular dance style.


7TH MATH

7th Grade math has been working hard on understanding and developing the concepts of Rates, Ratios, and Proportional Relationships. Within the Proportional relationship we have talked about scale factors and constants of proportionality. With these concepts, the students then are able to increase or decrease a certain relationship, such as a recipe, using this concept. For example, if a cookie recipe calls for 2 cups of flour and 1 cup of sugar, we can then use that ratio to make a larger or smaller batch of cookies by using scale factors and multiplying each of the items in the recipe by that number.

We are currently just finishing up with Unit 2 and will soon be starting Unit 3 which deals with Circles. Parts of a circle, measuring circles, and area and circumference of a circle.

WRESTLING

We are excited that the 2021 SMS Wrestling season is finally here! Our season opens up on November 2nd with a home meet against Emporia and Lakewood. We are returning several eighth graders who are looking to continue to build off of their momentum from last year as they provide valuable experience and leadership to our team.
